We have reached a decision regarding your submission to International Journal of Interactive Mobile Technologies (iJIM), "Instagram User Experience in Learning Graphic Design".

Our decision is to: **REVISIONS REQUIRED**

After collecting reviewers comments I feel that the manuscript is of potential interest to the readership of this journal, but there are major issues that must be addressed before the article could be published:

- /* I believe that you make a number of statements that are not backed up by research. They appear to be your opinion. Unfortunately, the readership of this journal is not interested in what you think. Instead it is interested in what you have proven by research!
- /* The literature review should be more carefully synthesised and structured. The use of sub-headings and signposting would help the reader to follow the argument being developed through the paper.
- /* What was the methodology used for the selection of relevant literature to review for purposes associated with this manuscript? In other words, what were the criteria that drove the search for key publications to support the literature review?
- /* The results section requires far greater organisation and structuring. The analysis is too general, and the reported results are somewhat selective. This section needs to be more carefully and systematically constructed.
- /* Further, the analysis and findings must be critical and interpretive rather than just descriptive.
- /* The final discussion and conclusion should make it clear how the findings contribute to new knowledge.
- /* The Methodology lacked suitable detail.
- /* Methodology of the central work is exposed appropriately.
- /* Research methodology based on research goals is poor on absent.
- /* The research/evaluation methodology is not justified, clear and appropriate (including ethical considerations / approval where appropriate)
- /* More recent bibliography is necessary. Furthermore, the reference list is a little bit weak. Before I can make a final decision on the paper, please refer to more references and upload a new version. It is suggested that the author(s) can consider the following papers related to eLearning, mobile learning, beliefs and attitudes, etc. to strengthen the background and conclusions of the study:



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
